**Appointment:**

The Department of Economics seeks to fill an academic-year Instructor position in Economics. Primary responsibilities include teaching four introductory and/or intermediate undergraduate-level courses in Management, Agribusiness Management, Entrepreneurial Studies, and/or Accounting per semester. This is a renewable, non-tenure track, 9-month appointment, with the possibility of summer teaching. Continuing appointment will be based on performance and funding.

Required qualifications: A Master's degree in Management, Agribusiness Management, Entrepreneurial Studies, Accounting, related area, or an MBA. Strong verbal and written communication skills, and strong presentation skills. Broad, general knowledge and expertise in at least one of the areas listed above are also required. Successful applicants must be willing and able to: (1) teach a broad set of courses in the department; (2) mentor and advise undergraduate students; and (3) prepare and instruct distance learning courses. Desired qualifications: Prior teaching experience at the college level, and prior teaching experience with online courses.

**Salary:** Commensurate with qualifications.
