

# On-Campus Transfer Admissions Policy

## REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO THE COLLEGE OF MANAGEMENT

<u>Admission to the College of Management is competitive and is based on academic record and space available in the college.</u> Courses in progress at the time of the application deadline will not be considered. Meeting the following requirements does not guarantee admission.

Students will be <u>considered</u> for admission if they meet all of the following requirements:

- attempted 30 hours of college level coursework (including at least 21 hours attempted at NC State)
- completed (with a C- or better) English 101 (or 111/112), or the equivalent
- completed (with a C- or better) Calculus (MA 121/131/141), or the equivalent

In addition to the above, students will be considered <u>competitive</u> for admission if they have achieved the following requirements. Meeting these achievements does not guarantee admission.

- 3.0 or better cumulative NC State GPA
- 3.0 or better College of Management GPA (calculated on ACC, BUS, EC courses)
- completion of 60 credit hours or less (i.e. students are encouraged to apply earlier in their program rather than later)
- leadership experience and co-curricular involvement may also be considered

#### **APPLICATION PROCEDURES**

Application Deadlines: February 15<sup>th</sup>, June 1<sup>st</sup> and Sept 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.

Applications will be reviewed immediately following each application deadline and **students will be notified of their admission status within one month of the deadline.** Completed applications should be returned to the Office of Academic Affairs in Nelson Hall. Following notification of admission, the College of Management will process curriculum change forms.

## RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

Accounting and Business Management majors must complete at least 30 credit hours (not restricted to courses in the major) while officially enrolled as a degree candidate in either Accounting or Business Management in order to graduate from the College of Management. Other residency requirements may apply as well (see College of Management General Policies).
