

## Minor in Business Administration

Students who fulfill the requirements for the undergraduate Minor in Business Administration will gain an understanding of the language and basic concepts of business, the fundamentals of economics, and core concepts of financial accounting. Expanding on that core foundation, students will pursue a focus in either general management or entrepreneurship. The Minor in Business Administration requires 18 hours of coursework with a 2.0 GPA in minor coursework and completion of the Software Applications Proficiency requirement (M 110).

### Course Requirements – Business Administration Core\*: (9 hours total)

<b>MIE 201</b> (formerly BUS 201)	Introduction to Business Processes	3 hours
<b>EC 205</b> (C- or better) **	Fundamentals of Economics	3 hours
<b>ACC 210</b> (C- or better)	Concepts of Financial Reporting	3 hours

\* ABM and TXM majors may count up to 6 hours of credit used to meet their major requirements.

\*\* EC 205 may be replaced by EC 201/ARE 201 (with C- or better) PLUS EC 202.

- ❖ Students may not take minor coursework on a credit only (satisfactory/unsatisfactory) basis.
- ❖ A 2.0 GPA or better is required in minor coursework.
- ❖ The Office of Undergraduate Programs must approve all transfer credits; no more than six hours can be transferred toward the minor.

### Applying for a Minor in Business Administration

Admission to the minor is competitive. Applicants are considered based on overall academic performance. To be eligible for consideration, a student must have completed at least 30 hours of coursework (not including courses currently in progress), with at least 15 successfully completed at NC State. Meeting these eligibility requirements does not guarantee admission to the Minor in Business Administration program: admission to the minor is competitive.

Accounting majors may not complete the Minor in Business Administration.

**Application Deadlines:** September 15<sup>th</sup>, February 15<sup>th</sup>, June 1<sup>st</sup>

**Notification:** Students will be notified one month after the application deadline regarding the status of their application.
