

NC State Online Math Placement Test

NC State University uses SAT Mathematics Level 2 test scores to determine which math course is most appropriate for each student. If you took the test in May or June, please ensure you requested that the College Board send your score to us electronically (our institution code is #5496). We are unable to accept score reports sent by applicants or reported on high school transcripts, so please make sure the College Board sends your score to us electronically.

Students without SAT II Mathematics Level 2 test scores are <u>REQUIRED</u> to complete the NC State Online Math Placement. If you do not take this test you <u>will not</u> be allowed to register for a calculus course during orientation.

To login and take the online placement test you will need your Unity ID and password. (Your Unity ID is displayed on your Admissions WolfPAW application status screen.) There is no charge for this test, which is available at https://www.webassign.net/ncsu/math.html.

The only exception to the placement test requirements will be for students who graduated from the NC School of Science and Mathematics and have letters of placement from the high school.
